









Project SEARCH is a one-year, business-led, unpaid internship program for students in their last year of high school or young adults with disabilities that takes place entirely at either host business site:

Newton Medical Center or Hackettstown Medical Center

How Project SEARCH Works

- Interns report directly to Newton Medical Center or Hackettstown Medical Center for a 10 month, 20 hours per week, internship program
- Daily soft skills classroom instruction combined with hands on internship experience
- Supports provided by certified employment and self esteem
 specialist and credentialed special education teacher
 Obtain work based individualized coaching,
- Explore careers with employment outcomes
- Receive travel training and long term supports
- Receive natural supports from hospital employees

Benefits

- Participate in a variety of internships within the hospital setting
- Acquire competitive, transferable, and marketable job skills
- Gain increased independence, confidence, and self esteem
- Obtain work based individualized coaching, instruction, and feedback
- Develop ties to Vocational Rehabilitation and other adult service agencies

The combination of instruction and immersion in the workplace prepares young adults with disabilities to make successful transitions from school to productive adult life.
