Eligibility:

- ✓ Student or June graduate must be between the ages of 14-21, reside and attend school in Warren, southern Sussex, western Morris or northern Hunterdon counties
- ✓ Be eligible for NJ DVRS services
- Commit to working a minimum of 10 hours per week for 150 hours
- Commit to orientation and virtual soft skills training, attending a minimum of 3 one hour sessions per week for 3 weeks before and after the internship.
- Have transportation to and from work- public transportation reimbursement available
- Willing and able to work independently at the job site with employer supervision
