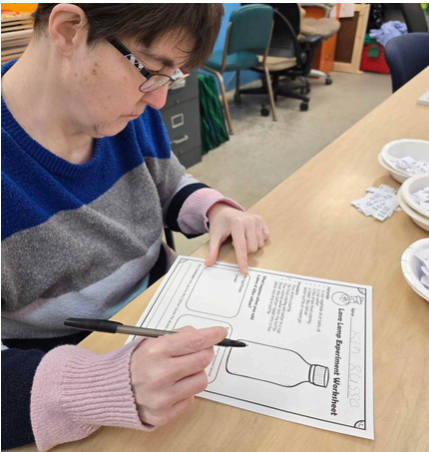

Lava Lamps Labs with Haley By Sarah

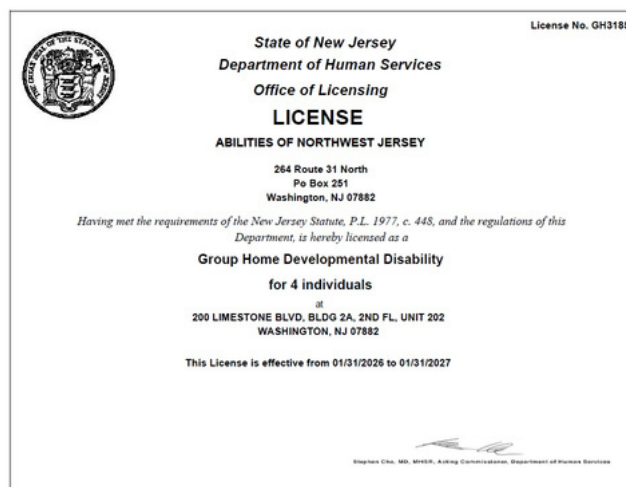
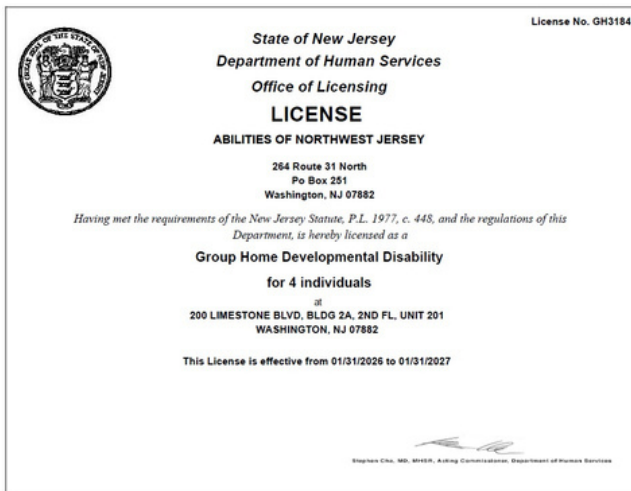
